



Oprah Winfrey Show in Chicago with 3-Night Stay and Airfare for (2)

The Oprah Winfrey Show – Enjoy (2) tickets to a live taping of *The Oprah Winfrey Show* at Harpo Studios on Chicago's Westside. **Oprah recently announced her show will be ending in 2011 after 25 years on the air.**

Winfrey said, "So, the countdown to the end of The Oprah Winfrey Show starts now, and until that day in 2011 when it ends, I intend to soak up every meaningful, joy-filled moment with you."

The show has been the highest-rated talk show for 23 consecutive seasons, according to the Oprah.com site. It is seen by an estimated 42 million viewers a week in the United States and is broadcast to 145 countries. The show had its origins in 1984, when Winfrey moved to Chicago to host WLS-TV's morning talk show, "AM Chicago", which became the #1 local talk show. The show surpassed ratings for "Donahue" one month after it began. Within a year, it expanded to an hour-long format and was renamed "The Oprah Winfrey Show" and entered national syndication in 1986.

Over the years, the show has made news on several occasions. In September 2004, Winfrey began a new season by giving each member of the audience a new car. In May 2005, Tom Cruise caused a sensation when he jumped up and down on Oprah's couch, declaring his love for actress Katie Holmes. Other guests have shared their personal struggles, such as Elizabeth Edwards, wife of former vice presidential candidate John Edwards; performer Whitney Houston and Lisa Niemi, widow of actor Patrick Swayze.

Audience members must be age 18 or over. The taping schedule varies from week to week and the show's seasons usually run from late August to November and from January to May. The final taping of the show is scheduled for September 9, 2011. Valid one year from date of purchase, subject to availability.
